

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

CITY OF ALBION, IDAHO PROPOSAL TO INCREASE CERTAIN MUNICIPAL FEES

NOTICE IS HEREBY PROVIDED that the Mayor and the City Council for the City of Albion, Cassia County, Idaho are holding a hearing on Tuesday, May 7, 2024 at 7:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard at the Albion Civic Center, 124 South Main Street, Albion, Idaho. The purpose of this hearing is to receive public comments on the proposal to increase certain municipal fees as hereinafter set forth, pursuant to provisions of Idaho Code Section 63-1311A. The increase is to cover the costs of administration, services and materials for such listed items, namely:




