**Subject:** Clarification Regarding Albion's Drinking Water Safety

Dear Residents of Albion,

It has come to our attention that certain information has been circulating implying that the drinking water provided by the City of Albion poses safety risks to its citizens. We want to assure you that this information is incorrect, and there has never been any threat to the safety of Albion's residents due to it's drinking water.

The City of Albion is dedicated to upholding both State and Federal compliance standards regarding our water system. We understand the critical importance of providing clean and safe drinking water to our community, and we take this responsibility very seriously.

To ensure the quality and safety of our drinking water, the City conducts monthly independent tests. I am pleased to inform you that the most recent test, conducted on 1st May 2024, returned results indicating that our water is clean and safe for consumption, as it has for many, many years.

Furthermore, we acknowledge the significance of addressing cross-connection issues to maintain water safety. In 2014, the City enacted Title 7, Chapter 6A, demonstrating our commitment to compliance and proactive measures in safeguarding our water system.
